

Summer Programs 2020

Sing, Laugh, Play!

Wednesdays,9:00-9:45am or 10:15-11:00am

Toddlers participate in fun language stimulating activities incorporating play, movement and music. Intended for ages 18-36 months and led by a Speech Therapist. A caregiver must attend with the child. More than one four-week session can be attended! Fee = \$120

Three Sessions: June 3 – 24 OR July 1 - 22 OR July 29 – August 19

Preschool Language (Two Hours) Mondays & Weds, 9:30-11:30am or 12:30-2:30pm Nine-week program designed for children with language delays. Children participate in a preschool routine with art, music, movement and play to target communication and interaction skills. Two Speech Therapists will lead the program. Minimum age of three by June 1. Fee = \$700 June 8 - August 5

Preschool Language (One Hour) Tuesdays & Thurs, 12:30-1:30pm or 2:00-3:00pm Nine-week program designed for preschool -aged children language delays. Children participate in art, music, movement and play activities that target communication and interaction skills. Two Speech Therapists will lead the program. Minimum age of three by June 1. Fee = \$350 June 9 – August 6

Speech Sounds Thursdays, 9:00-10:00am (ages 3-5) or 10:30-11:30am (ages 6-8) This group is designed for children with mild to moderate articulation delays. Attendees will participate in a variety of activities focusing on their accuracy in speech sound production. Fee = \$120 Two Sessions: June 11 – July 2 OR July 9-309

Early Childhood Literacy

Tuesdays & Thursdays

9:30-11:30am (Age 4 – Rising Kindergarten) OR 12:30-2:30pm (Rising Grade 1- Grade 2) Children participate in hands-on learning activities to improve phonological skills and build relationships with peers. Designed for children with mild to moderate speech and language delays. Two Speech Therapists will lead the program. Fee = \$700 June 9 - August 6

Social Groups Wednesdays, 9:00-10:00am (ages 5-7) or 10:30-11:30am (ages 8-10) These small groups provide the opportunity for children to target specific social language skills and build relationships with peers. Fee: \$120 Two Sessions: June 10 – July 1 OR July 8 - 29

Read, Write and Create

Thursdays, 9:00am-10:00am or 10:30-11:30am

Group session focusing on developing fine motor and language skills through reading stories, creating art and writing narratives. It will be led by a Speech Therapist and Occupational Therapist. This program is designed for children entering grades 1-4 with mild to moderate delays.

Fee = \$175Two Sessions: June 11 – July 2 OR July 9 - 30
